## Rules and Code of Conduct

### Welcome To Grotto Bay Private Nature Reserve

In order to avoid run-ins with our security personnel please respect our Nature Reserve and other guests and residents by adhering to these most obvious rules.



#### **No Open Fires**

Fire is a constant threat due to our Strandveldt vegetation. Fires are only permitted in designated fire places and braai areas of residences.



#### **No Loud Noise**

Ensure that your music or any other noise emanating from your house or vehicle does not cause an inconvenience to other residents.



#### **No Exterior Lights**

Please do not leave outside lights on as our wild life appreciates darkness at night. We do not have street lights for this reason.



#### **No Picking Plants**

Picking or removal of any fynbos, plants or flowers from the estate or the reserve outside of a private property is strictly prohibited.



#### No Dogs or Pets

Visitors staying in rented holiday accommodation are not allowed to bring any pets onto the Estate.



#### No Smoking

No smoking is permitted on the back of an open vehicle or while walking in the estate or nature reserve area.



#### **Traffic Rules**

The speed limit on the estate is strictly 40km/h. Obey all traffic signs and road rules. Pedestrians and children have the right of way.



#### **Walking After Dark**

During hours of dark any guest wanting to visit the beach or go for a walk outside the secure perimeter must first inform security.
